



Hi my name is Oscar; I would like you to help my friends because they are helping me.

I am 8 months old and my home is in Portstewart, Coleraine, Northern Ireland. At 6 months of age I was airlifted from Belfast to The Great North Children's Hospital, Newcastle upon Tyne on Boxing Day 2011.

I was born without an immune system and am unable to fight even minor infections. Something like the 'common cold' passed on to me by my mummy's kiss could be fatal.

I need to have a Bone Marrow transplant, and so for at least 6 months, I will be living in a high-tech sterile room known as 'The Bubble', where a fantastic team take care of me.
